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What you should know about teaching reading in English - 1

Why use phonics?

Reading in English is best taught by using phonics because English words cannot be spelled as you spell words in Bahasa Malaysia. You may want to teach reading by memorizing all the English words through Look and Say method, but will you be able to memorize the thousands of words there are in English? It will be too tedious.

The best choice would be to use **synthetic phonics**. It is currently the best reading method to teach reading. Synthetic phonics teaches the letter sounds and then builds up to blending these sounds together to achieve full pronunciation of whole words.

By using phonics children need to master the **sounds** (also known as phonemes) only and to associate the sounds to **symbols** (also known as graphemes). Once they master the sound-to-symbol association (Phoneme-Grapheme Association) they will blend the sounds into words to read (also known as decoding). 80% of English words can be decoded. By using synthetic phonics to teach children to read, they can make sense of print.

As for letter names (A, B, C, - pronounced 'ay' 'bee' 'see') they need not be taught to children in the beginning. It is not a prerequisite nor it is needed at all in synthetic phonics. Children will easily sound out words without having to know the letter names.

By using phonics, children can read as early as 4 years old. In three to six months, they will be able to read more fluently.

Researches in Scotland shows that children who are taught to read by using synthetic phonics are three years ahead compared to other students. It is now being used as the main method to teach reading to children as early as five years in England since 2007, in Brunei DS in 2008 and only recently in Malaysia, in 2010.



Teaching Single Sound

Step 1

Introduce the sound

After getting the children's attention, say to them:

"Today I'm going to teach you a new sound."

"Now, listen to me. Watch my mouth."

(then say the sound 5 times)

"What sound did you hear?"

Step 2

Practise saying the sound

Repeat the sound by saying :

"Good. Now say /k/ 5 times with me.."

"Everyone, say /k/, 5 times again."

"Group 1, say /k/ 3 times."

"Amy, say /k/ twice..."

Step 3

Show the symbol

Show the letter card. Point to the symbol and say:

Teaching the letter shapes and formation

Step 1

Trace the sandpaper letters



Tracing sandpaper letters the way the letter is written and saying the sound is one of the most basic sensory based activity that help children learn the letter shapes

Step 2

Form letters using clay



Use of modelling clay will help your child learn the letter shapes and formations that will help them associate sound and letter better.

Step 3

Do other sensorial activities

- a. Collage / mosaic
- b. Finger painting
- c. Letter cut-out



Step 4

Write the symbols

Writing can be done at best using fingers, marker pens, crayons, or paint brushes. Encourage writing through simple games.





Blending (Reading)

Step 1

Oral Blending

The teacher says each sound and the children guess the word. Start slowly and gradually move to a faster pace. You can also use the song below:

"If you are happy and you know it say the sound..2x
If you are happy and you know it and you really want to show it,
If you are happy and you know it say the sound.../c//a//t/"

Step 2

Blending using cards

Use cards to show how individual sounds can be put together to form words. Follow these simple steps:

- 1. Show how cards are put together to form words. Use a big pocket chart. a- Say the sounds e.g /k/.../æ/.../t/ as you put each card into the pocket chart.
 - b- Slide your finger from left to right as you read the word.
- 2. Ask children to say and blend the sounds with you
- 3. Ask children to say and blend the sounds by themselves as you move the cards.
- 4. Explain the meaning of words by showing real objects / pictures or actions.

Step 3

Do hands-on activity

Let children blend sounds using cards. Give each child a pocket chart and a set of four cards, i.e. 'c' 'a' 't' 'b'. Let them put cards in the pocket chart based on the following activities:



- 1. **Look and Build** the teacher shows a word card such as 'cat' and let children put the letter cards together to make the word.
- 2. **Listen and Build** teacher says a word, the children put the letter cards together to make the word.

Blending (Reading)

Step 4

Manipulation

You can help you child blend words by playing around with letter sound cards to the following activities:

- a. addition add a new sound
- b. deletion take away a sound
- c. substitution take away one sound and replace it with another
- d. repetition have two same sounds in the word

Segmenting (Spelling)

Steps

1. Using cards

Put cards 'b' 'a' 't' i.e. 'bat' on the board.
Ask children to read the word
Ask for the first sound they hear in the word,
then the second, and finally the last sound.
Move the cards away as the children segment the word.

2. Orally

The teacher says a word. The children say the individual sounds in the word. Encourage children to tap or use their fingers as they segment / spell the word.

3. Writing words

Have children write the words that they have learned.

You may use different tools for writing such as chalks, marker pens, crayons, paint brushes, and fingers. Your child may also do the writing activities in our ReadEasy Activity Books 1 and 2.
